

Town of Bell, Bayfield County, Wisconsin
All-Terrain Vehicle Route Ordinance
Ordinance No. 2010-2

The Town Board of the Town of Bell, Bayfield County, State of Wisconsin, being duly assembled at a Regular Town Board Meeting on Tuesday, MARCH 9, 2010, does hereby ordain the following All-Terrain vehicle ordinance in accordance with all Wisconsin Statutes defined in section 340.1 (2g) and including 23.33 (11),(8) (B) and NR 64.12 (1-6):

Section 1 - Intent

The Town of Bell, Bayfield County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of All-terrain upon roadways listed in Section 3. Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, these routes have been created.

Section 2 - Statutory Authority

These routes are created pursuant to village authority under section 1.1.01 as authorized by Wis. Statutes 23.33 (8) (b).
The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

Section 3 - Routes

All town roads in the Town of Bell open to ATV traffic shall be posted/signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12 (7)c. All other town roads not properly posted/signed, are then deemed not opened as ATV routes and will be considered closed.

Section 4 - Conditions

All ATV operators shall comply with Wisconsin All-Terrain Vehicle Laws.

Section 5 - Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of Bayfield County and The State of Wisconsin.

Section 6 - Penalties

All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in Wis. Stat. Section 23.33 (13) (a) are adopted by reference.


Section 7 - Severability


The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Bell would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

Section 8 - Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication.
This ordinance re-replaces/supersedes all/any previous ATV ordinances.


