It's pretty sad for us locals when we have to drive to town just to go swimming. When we go down there again to go swimming, we'll just barge our way through and if they say anything to us, I'll firmly tell them we are locals and if they want more beach area they can pack up and go to Corny.

The parking should definitely be addressed before the residents down there need a fire truck or ambulance and it can't get to them because the damn tourists have the road blocked.
